Pathway - Tenant and Residents Association

This is a new qualification that is suitable for tenants and residents and aims to provide the skills and knowledge to help them be actively involved in their activities with the housing organisation and their communities.

This pathway comprises of three units.

- The role and responsibilities of a community representative
- Key skills that a community representative needs
- Know their community including diversity and different needs
- Identify how to represent their community
