Welcome to the latest Tpas newsletter - your appointed Independent Tenant Advisor (ITA) for the Options Appraisal project for Alice Shepherd House and Oak House on the St John's Estate.

What's Happening

We're currently gearing up to appoint architects to work with the Resident Steering Group (RSG) to develop all of the options so we can present them to residents to choose their preferred option for the blocks. The architects should be appointed by early October and one of their first tasks will be to arrange an open exhibition for all residents so you can give your views on what should happen to the blocks. We've set out below the range of options that are available and the architects will be working with the community to look at what each could mean for everyone living here.

The Options

As you'll be aware, One Housing are looking at the future of the blocks with a range of potential options;

- Do nothing
- Refurbish the blocks
- Infill development
- Partial demolition and new build
- Demolition and new build



Nothing has yet been decided! ALL possible options will be considered — it's your choice! If you want to make your views known about what's good and bad about living in the blocks make sure you come along to one of the initial events. Alongside the information gathered from the survey undertaken by One Housing Group (as reported in the July newsletter), this will feed into the initial thoughts developed by the architects.

Surveys

You may notice different contractors on the estate carrying out surveys. This is all part of the background information that OHG are developing to make sure that the architects have all the information they need to look at what is possible on the estate.

These will be continuing over the coming months and, sometimes, they may want to get access into your home (please note that OHG will always contact you in advance if access is required). If you're ever in doubt as to who they are please contact Alison White or Mynul Islam at One Housing who will be able to confirm they are who they say they are. Never let anyone in who doesn't have the correct identification.
